21TH EDITION FROM 11TH TO 23TH JANUARY 2025










A merging of the LIMITED and OPEN categories in the main race which now only offers one category with a pool of 9 to 12 dogs.

A new distribution of prize money to reward all finishers and purebreed teams.

A return of the elite list for mushers with a prize list who want to guarantee their participation in the race.

A new race category with the possibility to race in DUO on the main race :

- Two mushers for a single team, which can alternate between each stage
- The opportunity to experience the race differently, or to group teams together to participate in it
- Same registration price as for individual mushers
- A specific classification apart from individual mushers, and no podium at the end of the stages
- No finisher status of La Grande Odyssée VVF
- The possibility of receiving race bonuses after all individual mushers finish




